This breed comes in several different colours such as; Fawn, Red, Blue, Brindle, and Black. Most breeders and owners of Cane Corsos dock their tails and crop their ears.

Cane Corso Temperament

The temperament of a Cane Corso if not socialized properly can result in aggression towards other animals and human. They require a lot of personal interaction between owner and dog. Cane Corso if left alone for too long can become destructive and agitated. Socialization is a must to promote correct temperament (traits you would want to see in your Cane Corso puppy are calm, stable, and protective). They can also be quite dominant so it is a must to form a mutual respect with your dog.

Can also show aggression against people and other animals if not socialized properly
